5. Read Leviticus 25:8-12 and Luke 4:18-21. How does the Jubilee preview our own redemption?
6. Read Leviticus 27:1-3. Why is God's faithfulness, especially to His vows and covenants, so important?
7. Read Galatians 3:10-14. What is the most impactful way you have seen the Law point to Christ in our study?
8. What is one practical way you can strive to live in faithful obedience this week because Christ has fulfilled the Law?
